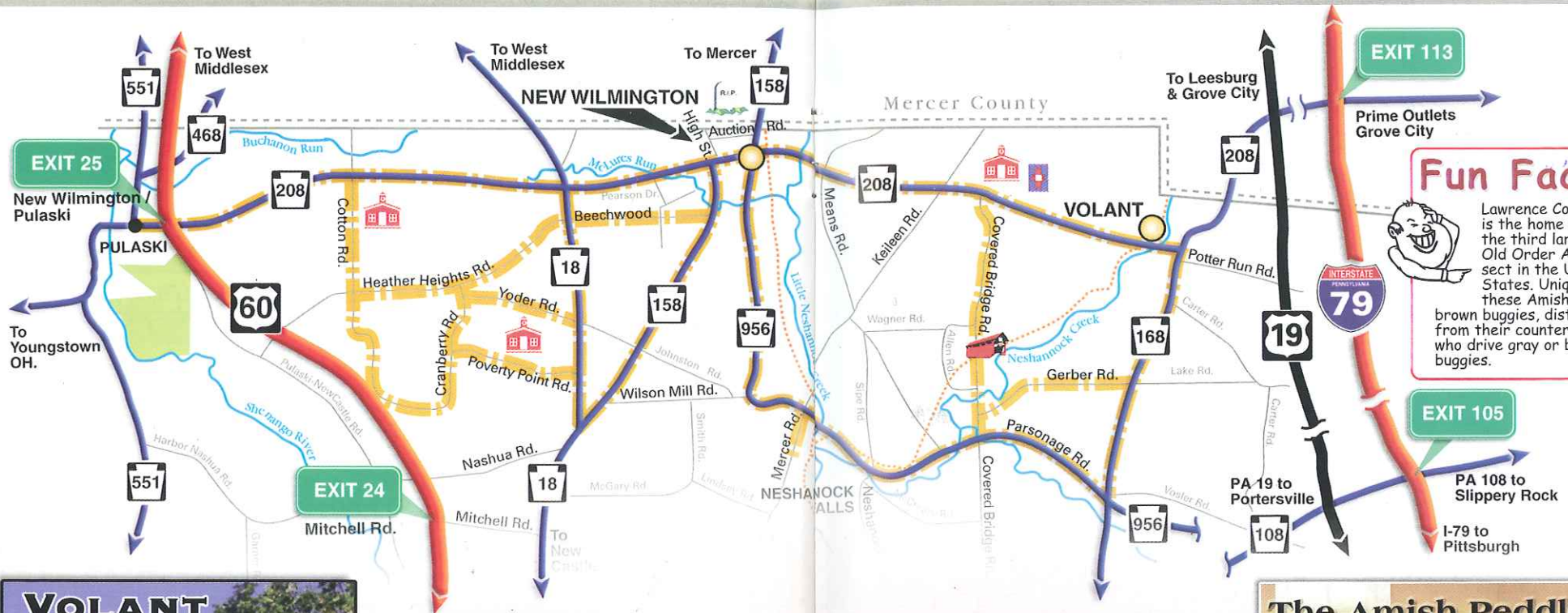


AMISH COUNTRYSIDE

An Old-Order Amish community of approximately 1,500 people is located along Route 208 surrounding the villages of New Wilmington and Volant. Descendants of Jakob Amman, the Amish have retained much of the same style clothing worn in the Palatine region of Switzerland during the sixteenth century.

Lawrence County is the home of the third largest Old Order Amish sect in the United States. Unique to these Amish are brown buggies, distinct from their counterparts who drive gray or black buggies.
